

# Special Meeting RCC re: OCA Membership

To summarize, at our last AGM, some of our members felt the cost of association membership is very high compared to the benefits received. The members requested a meeting with an OCA representative to obtain more information.

On October 2, an information session took place with Mr. Stephen Chenier, Executive Director of the Ontario Curling Association. He gave a presentation of the OCA programs and services, followed by a question and answer period. Attached is a letter from OCA discussing the value of membership in the association dated October 1, 2017.

Now the members need to vote on continuing or ending our OCA membership. An agenda has been attached for the Special Meeting.

The following points from our club's by-laws should be noted:

1. The club is required to give 7 days notice of a special meeting
2. Quorum for a Special Meeting is 30 Regular Members
3. No Proxy Votes are allowed
4. Only the business for which the Special Meeting has been called may be discussed
5. If a member did not receive the meeting notice, there is no impact on the outcome of vote
