RCC Falls on the Ice Policy

There are new signs posted around the Club pertaining to '**Falls on the Ice**'. The RCC Board of Directors has implemented a new policy that if you fall on the ice and hit your head, you are required to stop curling. Even if you feel okay or insist that you are okay, you are **NOT** permitted to return to the ice for the remainder of the day. You are also strongly advised to seek medical attention and monitor yourself for possible signs of concussion. The signs of concussion may include headache, nausea, dizziness, ringing in the ears, memory loss, drowsiness, and light sensitivity.
